This is a salaried, in-person (Portland-based) position with an anticipated schedule of 40hrs/week.



More about our Produce Buyer position:

We are seeking an experienced Buyer with a love of produce to contribute to our portfolio of purchasing categories, which also includes specialty groceries, craft confections and beverages, fine cheeses, meats, charcuterie, and the best natural, organic, and local goods we can find. The Produce Buyer will participate in company-wide retail and warehouse inventory management, and will work closely with co-buyers and department managers to conduct regular analysis of seasonal product variety, costs, and efficiencies. They will also collaborate with team members to build product representation, build supplier relationships, and strategize sales and merchandizing opportunities.

The Produce Buyer will contribute to Rosemont's mission to source locally as much as possible. Think of our Produce department as a year-round farm stand! This involves attention and strategy with respect to both small and large produce suppliers. Some of the primary goals for this position revolve around sales forecasting, shrink reduction, product quality, departmental profitability, staff training and education, and set design/ merchandising.

The ideal candidate for this position will also demonstrate the following criteria...

- Desire to expand personal knowledge of local producers and seasonal produce.
- Passion for local food systems, food economies, and specialty foods—especially produce!
- Exceptional interpersonal and communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Strong mathematical, computational, and analytical thinking skills.
- Confidence and accuracy with respect to budget and inventory management.

- Independent time-management skills and ability to sustain multiple ongoing projects.
- Advanced comprehension of spreadsheet functionality and excellent organizational systems.
- Proficiency in MS Office applications.
- English language proficiency required.

...And meet the following qualifications:

- High School diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum 3 years of professional experience in food commerce, or an advanced degree in a related field.
- Previous professional experience interfacing with POS systems and Inventory Control Systems.
- Previous professional experience with wholesale buying, vendor relations, and merchandising/sales strategy.
- Previous personal, professional, or volunteer experience interacting with specialty foods relevant to the purchasing categories.
